  - a. turn into two sentences
  - b. turn into a compound sentence (FANBOYS with comma)
  - c. use a semicolon (no FANBOYS nor comma)
- 8. direct address (comma/commas)
- 9. listing commas (words, phrases, etc.)
- 10. interjections (Wow, Hey, well, etc. notice the comma)
- 11. ellipsis (to show a pause "That's ... incredible!" I cried.)
